# FROM THE PASTOR

A few months ago, I alerted you to a scam where people pretend to be sending e-mails from the pastor. This is continuing to happen at churches throughout the U.S. The scammer gets e-mails from a bulletin and/or church website. For SJV, this is limited to people in ministries that have given permission to have their e-mail addresses available. If you get an e-mail with my name on it, you can verify it by looking at the e-mail address. I will only send SJV e-mails using [pastor@sjvchurch.net](mailto:pastor@sjvchurch.net). The scammer will have my name on the e-mail, but their e-mail address will be different from mine. Usually the scammer says, "I need you to buy some gift cards, please e-mail me." If you reply, they will then seek to get more information from you or have you send gift cards somewhere. Always feel free to call me or the office if you have any questionable e-mails appearing to be from SJV. It's sad scammers do this instead of using their skills to do good in the world.

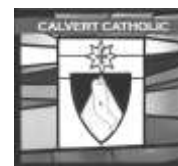
