I. Approval of Minutes.

II. Pastor's Report

III. Christian Beginnings pre-school

Letter to Pastoral Council distributed (see attached). Celebrating their 19th year. Had a full morning and afternoon classes for the first 10 years. Cost \$190/month, three days /week. This is a nine month program. Last year there was a \$12,000 deficit. This year is already at a \$2,000 deficit. There is one four year old class Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Tuesday and Thursday is a three year old class. There are two teachers retiring this year. An associate teacher will move up to fill one position. An aid will need to be hired. Program will be reevaluated at the end of this year.

IV. Committee Reports

Facilities and Physical Improvements Report (Handout included in minutes on file.) The south basement door needs to be repaired due to the building settling. Cathy Berger indicated that the moveable door/dividers in the old CCD classrooms need new handles.

Dave Michalko introduced **Mr. Felix Tang, Mr. Shafi Muguaddin and Ms. Denise ? from ?? Company**. Complete energy needs were looked at. More information is needed before they are able to complete the presentation. They want to be able to suggest what type of energy best fits our needs. It may not be just solar. Since topography is very important they would need a land survey of the churches property. John Weigel asked if this company does all the

work or do they sub the work out. The answer was yes to both. They estimate we would break even in five to seven years. They estimate that by February 2015 they should be able to furnish a complete report. The work will need to be done in phases. Maintenance costs will be included in the report.
