NEW FOOD PANTRY BUILDING

We are making great progress on the New Food Pantry Building Fund. We currently have about \$360,000 in cash and pledges.

We are well on our way to the needed \$400,000 for the new building.

WE NEED TO BUILD A NEW FOOD PANTRY !!!

Our Food Pantry has been operating for six years. It serves 130 to 150 families per week and the demand is still growing slowly.

Our volunteers are mostly elderly. We have about 80 people who volunteer one time per month at the Food Pantry, so we have 20 per week.

We are moving thousands of pounds of food up and down stairs in the old house on Main Street. It is dangerous and inconvenient.

Feeding the poor is one of the corporal works of mercy. It is mentioned by Jesus in the final judgment discourse in Mathew 25. He says we will be judged by how we treated the poor.

What will we build?

A 3000 sq. ft. building, concrete slab on grade

Where will we build it?

On our property along Holy Family Lane, near the Family Life Center.

How much will it cost?

Our best guess is about \$400,000 for the building and furnishings including shelving, walk-in freezer and refrigerator, and a palate jack.

How long will it take?

If we raise the money this summer, we should be able to get permissions from the Archdiocese and the County in the fall. If all goes well it should be completed in the Spring, 2018.

What will happen to the old food pantry facility?

This is up to Fr. Carson. Probably we will move the Ladies Club materials out of Fr. Julio Alvarez basement into the house on Main St.
