He said, "It took me about 2 years, a lot of grace, and the prayers of many people to help me decide to enter seminary. I was in my third year of college and Fr. Rob Walsh helped me understand what the priesthood actually was. He gave me the book "To Save A Thousand Souls" by Fr. Brett Brannan which helped me with a lot of questions I had, and Fr. Rob challenged me to enter deeper into my faith. I began to surround myself with the sacraments, going to daily mass, going to confession regularly, and praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament. As I continued through the rest of college the calling to the priesthood started to become clearer, which helped me to fully commit to discernment and seminary." Stephan also walked the Camino de Santiago de Compostela.
