We are a faith based interdenominational Christian ministry that meets at the Family Life Center of St. John Vianney Catholic Church; 105 Vianney Lane; Prince Frederick, MD 20678. Our mission is to provide moral, spiritual and practical support to recently released inmates from the Calvert County Detention Center. This is primarily a mentoring program that will, in addition, provide practical advice in locating food, clothing, housing, job skills and jobs.

Why would I want to participate in H.I.T.T.S.?

If you are looking for a mentor, and friends who will give you practical, useful help in a friendly place – a place where you can share your concerns and struggles and successes as you transition back to a successful return to life on the “outside,” then give H.I.T.T.S. a try. We will provide you both support and accountability.

Who is eligible to participate in H.I.T.T.S.?

Soon to be released inmates, identified by officials at the Calvert County Detention Center in conjunction with the program coordinator of the H.I.T.T.S. program. The program will be open to those released inmates who plan to reside Calvert County. We will provide reasonable resources for those who wish to relocate elsewhere.

When and where do you meet?

The program is available on the Second Thursday of the month from 7:30 P.M.-9:00 P.M. at the St. John Vianney Catholic Church Family Life Center.
